2. Are you certified in CPR?

If not, you must be in order to get your license!

3. You will need a 2" x 2" passport-type photo to  
submit with your application for licensure.

It must be taken within 12 months of when you apply!

4. You must submit electronic fingerprints along with your application for licensure.
